Provider Travel Costs

Travel within Karratha (school, daycare, home and community appointments) will have a standard 15 minute charge to cover preparation for the clinician and the time taken to drive to and from the appointment. This charge will be calculated at the same rate as the cost of the clinical appointment associated with the travel time.

Pricing Policy

The above private prices were set based on the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) Price Guide 2020-21 released 1 December 2020 under the Remote and Very Remote categories. The National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) sets the price for therapy supports to ensure value for money for participants. Connect PTS relies on the extensive research undertaken by the NDIA in identifying market trends and cost of business for allied health services to set prices and ensure sustainability of services. Reviews by the NDIA are undertaken annually in the lead up to a new financial year, with any new prices outlined in an updated price guide, effective 1 July each year.
